

ADR Driver Training



The ADR driver training certificate is an essential legal requirement for drivers of vehicles transporting dangerous goods accredited by the Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA).

ADR (Accord Dangerous Routier) are European regulations concerning the international transport of dangerous goods by roads.

Courses will depend on the goods being carried and the vehicle in which substances are being transported.

Core training is required by all drivers. Packaged goods training and a tanker module are also available for drivers whose work requires these modules.

Class outlines

- Class 2: Gases
- Class 3: Flammable Liquids
- Class 4: Flammable Solids
- Class 5: Oxidising Substances and Organic Peroxides
- Class 6: Toxic and Infectious Substances
- Class 8: Corrosive Substances
- Class 9: Miscellaneous Substances

The standard course: core, packages and 7 classes

This 4-day course covers basic legal, safety and security requirements for the transport of dangerous goods by road. Additionally, there will be an overview of regulations for rail, sea and air.

The course also includes the basic requirement for the transportation of dangerous goods except explosives and radioactive materials.

The full course: core, packages, tanks and 7 classes

This 5-day course includes all the topics in the standard course, as well as the requirements for the transport of dangerous goods by road tanker or tank containers.
